My primary roles in my last term as Student Councilor included: 1) fielding questions concerning CAG specific items with individual members; 2) Creating website content for student members

- 1. I was in dialogue with students for a number of months preceding the student travel grant deadline (February 2018). These discussions pertained most often to questions about membership procedure, applying for the travel grant, and what is involved with the Student Councilor position.
