

Getting to/from MUN Campus

Here are the transportation options available for travel between St. John's International Airport and MUN's St. John's campus, or around town:

- 1. **Taxi:** You can find taxis outside the arrivals area. The approximate travel time from the airport to MUN campus is around 15-20 minutes.
- 2. **Uber**: Look for the designated area for ride-sharing pickup at the Airport. Download the app on your mobile device and request a ride to MUN Campus.
- 3. **Public transport** (Metrobus): Route 14 connects the Airport, various city locations, and MUN. Go to the designated bus stop outside the airport terminal. Route 14 runs hourly or every hour and a half, depending on the time. Check departure times on the Metrobus website (https://www.metrobus.com/SchedulesOverview/). The fare is \$2.50 per person, so have the exact change ready.
- 4. Accessible services: For accessible transit, contact GoBus Accessible Transit at (709) 368-1620 or Wheelway Transportation Limited at (709) 753-0605. It is recommended to give 24 hours' notice. To learn more, visit destinationstjohns.com/accessibility-in-st-johns.

Staying on MUN Campus

If you are staying on campus in the guest accommodations:

Address: 40 Livyers Loop, St. John's, NL, A1B 3P7

To check-in, please follow these instructions: Go inside the main entrance of Macpherson College, which is located on Livyers Loop (accessible from Prince Philip Drive). The front desk is situated below the skywalk, at the north end of the complex.

If you take the bus from the airport, you will be dropped off at the University Center (UC). From the University Centre, walk east on Arctic Avenue past the Earth Sciences building, take a right on Morrisey Avenue, and cross Prince Philip Drive intersection onto Livyers Loop. See enclosed map.





Wayfinding on MUN Campus



The map provides information on all amenities on campus, including key buildings, parking areas, recreation facilities, Wheelchair accessibility routes, food services, and more.

There are underground tunnels on campus called "MUNnels" that provide convenient passage between buildings. On the interactive map, you can select the "St. John's Campus tunnels" option to help you find your way through these tunnels.


Amenities on MUN Campus

University Centre: The University Centre is a central gathering place on campus with spaces for studying, socializing, and various services. The building houses the University bookstore (2nd Floor, UC-2006) for stationery and university merchandise. The 3rd floor has a post office, an RBC ATM, a dental clinic, a food court and a convenience store. (See <u>Campus Map</u>)

Food on campus: There are a range of dining options on campus, including food courts and coffee shops. The University Centre's food court has Booster Juice, Just Fries, Manchu Wok, Mary Brown's Chicken Express, and Pizza Delight. Bitters Pub and Restaurant is located in Feild Hall, across Prince Philip Drive. Two coffee shops open during summer on campus are: Tim Horton's in the Arts and Administration Building's Atrium and a Jumping Bean in the QEII Library. Slightly further afield, <u>The Pantry Cafe</u> (operated by the Autism Society) is located near the Health Sciences Centre, across Prince Philip Drive. **Note: breakfast options on campus are limited!**

Internet access: Visitors can access the internet using the @Memorial-Guest network (no password requited) or eduroam.

Family/nursing space: We have set aside SN2007 as a quiet space for families and nursing mothers. For access, please inquire at the main office, SN2012.



Take a movement break

Need a break from sessions or want to "Think Outside" with a colleague? A short walking trail around Burton's Pond (near the residences) is nearby. The moderate Long Pond loop trail (~3 km in length) in Pippy Park is accessible from campus (cross Prince Philip Drive from Livyer's Loop). Amenities nearby MUN Campus


Other establishments:

Directions: From the guest accommodations, walk along the pond in the direction of Burton's Pond Road, heading towards Guy Court residences (away from Science Building). Follow the walking path located between Cartier House and Gilbert House until you reach the traffic intersection at Allandale Road and Elizabeth Avenue. Cross the traffic light at the intersection, then turn left and continue walking on Elizabeth Avenue for approximately 300 meters. See Map B.
