

## **STUDENT TRAVEL GRANT FOR THE ACAG ANNUAL MEETING (effective September, 2018)**

### **DIVISION TRAVEL GRANT**

In 2004 the CAG Executive Committee decided to make available to each of the four regional divisions a student travel grant of \$1,500. This grant is to be used to defray the costs of students travelling to the annual meeting in the region, and all decisions relating to the criteria for the selection of recipients, and the amount of individual awards are left entirely to the discretion of the individual regional associations. The following eligibility, application, and award procedures will be used by ACAG.

### **ELIGIBILITY**

The student must:

1. be registered for the annual meeting to deliver an oral or poster presentation; and
2. be a student at an institution in the Atlantic Canada region.

### **APPLICATION**

Applications should be submitted by e-mail to the current ACAG Secretary-Treasurer (see [http://community.smu.ca/acag/about\\_acag.html#executive](http://community.smu.ca/acag/about_acag.html#executive))

The student should apply before the annual meeting, with a request for essential travel expenses only (transportation, and accommodation up to \$50 per night for two nights).

### **AWARD**

The President and Treasurer will adjudicate awards and determine the funds available to be given to approved applicants.
